INDOOR AIR QUALITY DISTRICT IONIZERS INSTALLED

100% of ionizers have been installed in District schools and administrative locations.

Approximately 90% of District schools and administrative locations have had before and after air quality tests completed. Units are working well to introduce air-purifying ions into the air to improve indoor air quality.
