Shelby County Board of Education Procurement and Contracts Committee Update

MEETING SUMMARY

The Procurement and Contracts Committee met on August 17 to discuss numerous updates on many services including Board Attorney Proposals, District-wide Filter Replacement Services, the United Elevator Contract Amendment, and more.



DISTRICT-WIDE FILTER REPLACEMENT SERVICES

Recommendations were made requesting the Board to approve the contract to National Fliter Solutions, Inc. for the District-wide HVAC filter replacement project. This project will aid in the improvement of better filtration, air quality, and energy costs, and cleaner coils.

MATA BUS CARDS FOR INNOVATIVE/ALTERNATIVE SCHOOLS

Recommendations were made for the Board to approve the purchase to MATA (Memphis Area Transit Authority) for bus cards that will be issued to students in innovative and non-traditional schools for transportation during the 2021-22 school year. Eligible students will receive bus cards for use on school days only. MATA will invoice SCS monthly, based on the students' use of the transportation services.



SCS DISTRICT-WIDE WATER DISTRIBUTION

Recommendations were made for the Board to approve the purchase of The Water Source for 12,344 cases of bottled water for District-wide distribution to students and staff. The total amount includes the initial purchase approved by the Board in April.

WATER BOTTLE FILLING STATIONS

Recommendations were made for the Board to approve the award to All Rite Plumbing Parts, Inc. for the purchase of 3,000 water bottle filling stations for use throughout all SCS schools and administration buildings. This purchase will allow the District to prevent shared usage of traditional drinking fountains to eliminate the transmission of COVID-19 and other diseases. The stations will also provide improved water filtration to reduce lead levels and other impurities in drinking water.

MWSBE SPEND PRESENTATION

The MWSBE (Minority, Women-owned, and Small Business enterprises), presented its certified spending data from various spending categories including construction, architecture and engineering, professional services, non-professional services, and goods and supplies.
