OCTOBER 2021 BUDGET AMENDMENT

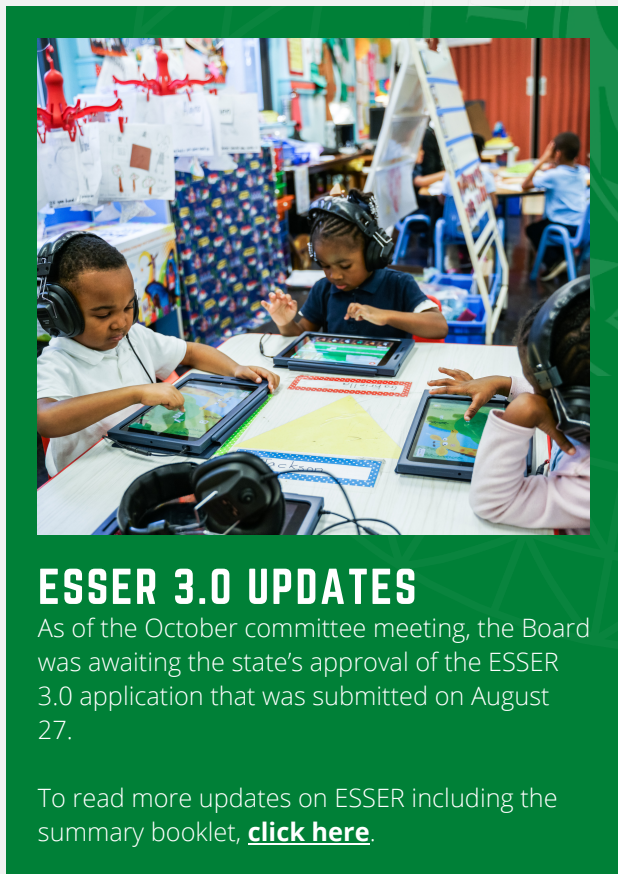
