The YFRC connects youth and their families with individualized services, support, and resources in the community. We call and schedule an appointment with the youth's caregiver.

We ask for them to come in for a scheduled assessment with a youth advocate so we can gather some information about their current situation and identify strengths and needs. Through that assessment, we gain a better understanding of current barriers and work with the family to create an action plan intended to guide and connect them to the proper resources. At that point, the youth advocate ensures a warm handoff has been made and the family is connected to the resource, and additional case management will take place if necessary.
