IFB 103124DW FIRE ALARM INSPECTION, TESTING AND MONITORING

1. Can you provide us with a previous year's annual inspection report for these facilities? If not, a zone list for each of the fire systems would be very helpful.

Please review the attached school location list that identifies the fire alarm make and model. The previous year's inspection reports will be shared with the awarded vendor.

2. Will there be a list of fire alarm devices for each school listed anywhere so that we can price up each school for the inspections?

Please review the attached school location list that identifies the fire alarm make and model.

3. Since you have cellular dialers at all schools will you be given the passcode by your current provider so they can be re-used? That would cut the cost way down. There is a form for your current provider to release each cell dialer so the next company can take over.

No, we will not be given the passcode by the current provider.

4. We need the information on each location containing the fire alarm panel make/model and device count. When will the information be provided?

Please review the attached school location list that identifies the fire alarm make and model.

5. Is there a fire alarm inspection testing schedule that will be provided for all locations? Or will we be allowed to schedule at our discretion?

A schedule will be determined in collaboration with the vendor and MSCS.

6. What locations need fire smoke damper testing? Will the counts be provided along with a required testing schedule?

Inspections are to include but not limited to testing of the fire detection system, activating outputs for the purpose of equipment shutdown, start-up, HVAC/smoke control, elevator recall, and door release functions. Locations will be identified through review of the previous year's inspection reports with the awarded vendor.

7. What is the timeframe for installing the cellular dialer and programming the fire alarm for monitoring?

Cellular dialer is to be installed no later than 60 days from the contract start date.

8. Will a bid pricing form be uploaded that will have each location listed individually?

Please review the attached school location list.

9. To clarify, does the requested cost for the fire alarm inspections include any service coverage?

There are two separate solicitations under the fire alarm scope. One for inspection, testing, and monitoring, and one for maintenance and service repair.

10. Can MSCS provide a comprehensive list of all the fire smoke dampers for each school, including dates of the last inspections for each damper?

No. There is not a comprehensive list available.

11. If a list can not be provided, how would MSCS like the vendors to proceed with locating all the fire smoke dampers at each school?

Inspections are to include but not limited to testing of the fire detection system, activating outputs for the purpose of equipment shutdown, start-up, HVAC/smoke control, elevator recall, and door release functions.

12. At the start of the 1st inspection zone 1 thru 4 would MSCS like to have the fire dampers inspected alongside of the annual fire inspection?

Inspections are to include but are not limited to testing of the fire detection system, activating outputs for the purpose of equipment shutdown, start-up, HVAC/smoke control, elevator recall, and door release functions. Inspection of the smoke dampers are not to be considered a separate inspection but a part of the annual inspection as outline in the scope.
