Employee Social Media Policy

The Board of Education provided updates on the employee social media policy. The proposed new policy provides the following guidance to assist employees in making responsible decisions about the appropriate use of social media. The guidelines cover the bases of numerous activities, including prohibited activities, use of social media at work and/or on District Equipment, use of Information/content obtained from work on social media, unauthorized district representation on social media, engagement with students on social media, district-authorized social media accounts operate by employees, as well as sanction for violations of the policy. This policy will go before the Board for a second reading and approval in June 2021.

Administrative Rules and Regulations

Other updates, which did not require Board action, included the administrative rules and regulations for policy #5015 Grading System for Grades 6-12. The revisions provide additional criteria for exemption from semester exams.
