

DENTAL SEALANT

Is a white resin (plastic) material that is placed in the pits and fissures of the chewing surface of permanent teeth.

Dental sealants fill in and smooth out the grooves and fissures in your teeth that tend to hide food particles and attract cavity-causing bacteria. According to the American Dental Association, sealants work by "sealing out food and plaque because toothbrush bristles cannot reach those deep grooves and depressions found in normal tooth anatomy. The American Dental Association recommends that sealants are placed as soon as the adult teeth erupt.

Dental sealants can protect the teeth for up to 10 years but need to be checked frequently (every 6 months) by a dental professional to ensure that they are still present and not defective.

Dental sealants have been shown to reduce the risk of cavities in the teeth that are covered.

There are no drills or needles involved in the dental sealant process.
