2023-24 ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the program must:

- Submit a copy of the most recent comprehensive report card showing A's and B's, with no more than one C as a semester average in academic subjects and no D's or F's as a semester average in any subject.
- Score at or above the 80th percentile on school-based administration of the i-Ready Diagnostic Reading and Math assessments (2022-23); or score at or above the 80th percentile on the TCAP Achievement English Language Arts and TCAP Achievement Mathematics assessments; or score at or above the 80th percentile on the Total Reading/Reading Composite and Total Mathematics/ Mathematics Composite of an acceptable nationally normed achievement test. Acceptable tests in person must be dated Spring 2022 or later.
- Score at or above the 80th percentile on a TCAP English and Mathematics End of Course test and/or another acceptable nationally normed achievement assessment, including the ACT (Reading and Math), PSAT or SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Mathematics) with the assessment being administered in person no more than one year prior to the date of application for Optional Schools.
- Have satisfactory conduct grades and attendance records, including promptness to school and to each class, with no more than a total
 of 15 absences and/or tardies.
- Students are required to enroll in Honors level or above courses beginning in grade nine and continuing through grade 12. Students are required to take all courses required for graduation at the Honors, Pre-AP/AP level.
- Students who maintain the Optional renewal requirements for White Station Middle School will be accepted into White Station High School's Optional Program on a continuation basis.
- To remain in the Optional Program, a student must maintain an average of C or above in each subject per semester. The entrance requirements for conduct and attendance must also be maintained.
- Final approval is contingent upon review of the student's second semester/final report card issued June 2, 2023.
- Transportation to the school is the responsibility of the student's parents/legal guardians.
